Both RAW and JPEG files can be edited this way. Uses ACR as a plug in.

Before and After Using "Auto"



When Done...



DONE – applies changes, creating .xmp file, and closes image OPEN – applies changes, creating .xmp file, and opens image in rest of Elements

CANCEL – cancels changes and closes image

Other Ways to Adjust Color



Basic Color Adjustments in Topaz Studio 2

Studio 2 can open RAW files, probably uses camera profiles.

- Other Topaz products such as DeNoise use camera profiles
- Once you have decided on filter settings for your camera, that set of settings can be saved as a Look, Studio 2's equivalent to a preset

Studio 2 Basic Correction filter has most controls that ACR has

Other filters exist for HSL, curves, dual tone (split tone), dehaze, etc.

All Topaz products, including Studio 2, can be used as plugins in Photoshop, Lightroom, and Elements
